The Australia Zoo Wildlife Hospital is now one of the largest and busiest of its kind in the world, treating thousands of animals every year. Open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, it provides a free service to the community as well as educating and inspiring visitors to make a difference to our world through conservation.

**DID YOU KNOW?**

- On average 6000 wildlife patients are admitted each year
- The majority of patients are victims of car accidents and domestic pet attacks
- Up to 100 koalas can be in care at any one time
- The biggest threat to koalas after habitat loss is chlamydial disease
- The Rescue Unit responds to wildlife emergency calls seven days a week.
